(Linz, November 3, 2015) A documentary film about an extraordinary working & living community will be the featured presentation at the next Deep Space LIVE this Thursday, November 5 at 8 PM. "Schale für Schale" (Husk by Husk) is about the Purtscheller family in Buchkirchen, Upper Austria, full-time professional farmers who lead a self-determined existence in harmony with nature and offer opportunities for young and old to take part in everyday life in their agricultural community. The offerings include child care, social welfare projects and animal-supported forms of therapy.

About the presenters

Herwig Kerschner is a filmmaker and freelance artist in Linz who, in addition to his creative activities, is also an infotrainer at the Ars Electronica Center Linz. Violetta Wakolbinger is a photographer and freelance artist in Linz. Both are enrolled in the Time-based Media program at Linz Art University.
