Kinderkulturwoche: Workshops and Events for the Youngest

(Linz, October 7, 2024) The Linz Children's Culture Week ("Kinderkulturwoche Linz") starts on Wednesday, 9 October and offers a colorful program at around 30 participating cultural institutions in Linz up to and including Sunday, 20 October. The program includes 250 events for children from the age of three and up and their families. At the Ars Electronica Center, the Kid's Research Lab will once again be an experimental area, workshops will invite visitors to take part in hands-on activities and in Deep Space 8K visitors will need to use their whole body.

In the Space Debris Tentacles creative workshop, children aged eight and up will explore how space can be kept clean and how the Earth's orbit can be protected from space debris. After conducting experiments together, the children will develop ideas on how to effectively remove space debris, taking inspiration from nature.
