(Linz, April 11, 2011) Linz artist Norbert Artner and Martin Hochleitner, director of the Landesgalerie Linz, cordially invite you to accompany them on a photographic excursion this Thursday in Deep Space. Their images of ateliers and studios will present places where art is not just put on display but where it is actually created.

#### Norbert Artner

Artist Norbert Artner has taught at Linz Art University since 1995. For about the last four years, he has focused on all sorts of locations in which art is produced, whereby his photographs of ateliers and studios document actual, specific working situations. Artner's photographic technique of assembling each image from numerous individual shots leads to what is simultaneously a construction and deconstruction of reality. New York is one of the many places where he has exhibited his work.

#### Martin Hochleitner

Martin Hochleitner studied classical archaeology and art history in Salzburg. He has been director of Landesgalerie Linz since 2000. Hochleitner possesses a profound knowledge of photography. He has served as a member of the Austrian Federal Chancellery's Photographic Advisory Council. In 2007-08, he taught photographic theory at the University of Applied Arts Vienna. In 2008, he was appointed Professor of Art History at Linz Art University.
