(Linz, 19.11.2015) At the next Deep Space LIVE: Panoptikum this coming Thursday, November 19th at 8 PM, Gerfried Stocker, artistic director of Ars Electronica, Futurelab director Horst Hörtner and museum director Christoph Kremer will present selected online content about the fighting in Syria and Iraq and its various upshots including destruction, radicalization and waves of refugees. They'll also elaborate on Project Mosul in which scientists are utilizing old photos to create 3-D computer models depicting destroyed cultural treasures.
