





So does movement — a phenomenon so inherent for life and the universe, that without movement, there would be no us. Yet, we find ourselves forcing our movement expressions into silence, conforming to restricted ways of moving and not owning the space we are meant to take.

Mosaic of memories invites you to feel your experiences and create memories with movements. A space for you to explore what movement means for you and where it can take you. A space to contemplate, reflect, and react - in movements - to explore moving bodies in the space around us. Pritha and Aman explore how our lived experiences takes us into movement and shares their mosaic of memories with you - they share what moved them - thoughts, words, places, feelings, and senses - and invites you to explore what moves you.

Using sensor-assisted interactivity, we create a space surrounded by stories of moving bodies and movement in space where you have the agency to find the stories. We share our research of movement on camera - an impulse for you to discover your expression in movement.
